Clue 1 - It's a Grey Area

The word ending with the most matching words is **-able**, so the ancient creature must have been **green**.

Clue 2 - Lettuce Investigate!

The correct spellings should read:

cried

shield

thief

believe

chief

ceiling

height

either

deceive

receipt

neighbour

niece

I can see that **neither** was used most often so the ancient creature must have been an **omnivore**.

Clue 3 – Eye I Can Knot Not Believe It!

The passage of text should read:

The Paradise Werecat: a creature **who's** very wary of others. Live in **herds**, **led** by the **father** figure (unless a **guest** is present who is **allowed** to **precede** the group). Often seen roaming **past desert** lands in the early **morning**.

There were **10** spelling errors so the ancient creature must have lived on **land**.

Clue 4 – Judging by Its Cover(ing)

The verb prefix with the most matching words is **re-**, so the ancient creature must have been covered with **scales**.

Clue 5 – Sizing up the Enemy

Sentence	Dash or Hyphen?
The creature – which was over six feet tall – had two hind legs.	Dashes
I wasn't very fond of the Frost Sphynx – it was very lazy.	Dash
No one has ever found a genuine full-length Crystal Hawk skeleton.	Hyphen
The Bog Shadow – a mysterious creature – has never been captured.	Dash
Some ancient creatures were incredibly bad-tempered.	Hyphen
The historic, green-eyed chameleons did not stand a chance against them.	Hyphen
I thought the search was over – I'd discovered almost every ancient beast.	Dash
We need to take an in-depth approach to our research.	Hyphen
These creatures came from far-flung corners of the world.	Hyphen
The Regal Griffin could let out an ear-piercing shriek.	Hyphen
Take another look – your predictions may not be accurate.	Dash
I may need to re-examine some of the evidence.	Hyphen

There are 5 uses of dashes and 7 uses of hyphens.

Statement	Outcome	True?
There are the same amount of dashes and hyphens.	The creature is less than 1m tall.	
There are more hyphens than dashes.	The creature is between 1m and 2m tall.	
There are more dashes than hyphens.	The creature is between 2m and 3m tall.	
There are no dashes at all.	The creature is between 3m and 4m tall.	
There are no hyphens at all.	The creature is over 4m tall.	

The ancient beast slain by Saint George was the Crested Crawler.
