#### Clue 1 - It's a Grey Area

The word ending with the most matching words is **-able**, so the ancient creature must have been **green**.

#### Clue 2 - Lettuce Investigate!

The correct spellings should read:

I can see that neither was used most often so the ancient creature must have been an omnivore.

#### Clue 3 - Eye I Can Knot Not Believe It!

The passage of text should read:

The Paradise Werecat: a creature **who's** very wary of others. Live in **herds**, **led** by the **father** figure (unless a **guest** is present who is **allowed** to **precede** the group). Often seen roaming **past desert** lands in the early **morning**.

There were 10 spelling errors so the ancient creature must have lived on land.

### Clue 4 - Judging by Its Cover(ing)

The verb prefix with the most matching words is **re-**, so the ancient creature must have been covered with **scales**.





# Clue 5 - Sizing up the Enemy
