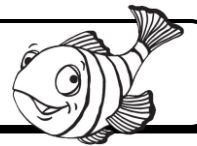


# Pronouns

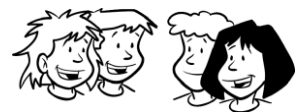
