

Add a three-digit number and ones (mentally)

- 1 Isiah has **116** toy cars. For his birthday, he gets another **3**. How many toy cars does Isiah have now?



- 2 Sarah collects stamps. She has **250** and then gets **9** more. How many does she have now?

- 3 There are **105** boys and **7** girls in the football tournament. How many children are in the football tournament altogether?

- 4 Kyle's football team have scored **123** goals so far this season. In the next **two** matches, they score **4** goals and **7** goals. How many goals have they scored altogether?

- 5 On Saturday, a takeaway sold **134** poppadoms. Kyle then bought **5** and Isiah bought another **7**. How many poppadoms have been sold now?

- 6 There are **117** grapes, **8** oranges, **9** bananas and **5** melons left in the fruit shop at the end of the day. How many pieces of fruit are left altogether?



Add a three-digit number and tens (mentally)

- 1 Sarah can skip **122** times with her skipping rope without stopping. Jessica can skip **20** more times than Sarah without stopping. How many times can Jessica skip?

- 2 Humma and Sarah go swimming every day for a week. Humma swims **114** lengths and Sarah swims **30** lengths. How many lengths do they swim altogether?



- 3 In the fruit shop, there are **190** apples and **20** pineapples. How many apples and pineapples are there altogether?

- 4 There are **17** children on the school bus. At the first stop, **20** children get on and, at the second stop, another **10** children get on. How many children are on the bus now?

- 5 Sarah was baking for a charity sale. She baked **123** chocolate biscuits, **80** plain biscuits and **40** cupcakes. How many biscuits and cakes did Sarah bake altogether?

Add and subtract a three-digit number and hundreds (mentally)

- 1 Between 9 am and 5 pm a café sold **200** cups of coffee and **145** cups of tea. How many drinks did they sell altogether?



- 2 There are **328** sweets in a tub. Humma and Isiah eat **200** of the sweets. How many sweets are left?

- 3 Siddiq and his grandad are making a cake. They start by putting **175 g** of sugar and **300 g** of butter into a bowl. How many **grams** of sugar and butter are in the bowl?

- 4 Sarah is making necklaces. She has **762** beads. She uses **100** beads to make a necklace for her mum and **300** beads to make a necklace for her sister. How many beads does she have left?

- 5 Kyle has **756** trading cards. Isiah has **300** cards and Jessica has **100**. How many more trading cards does Kyle have than Isiah and Jessica put together?
