Predicting Pip



What Does Predicting Pip Do?

Predicting Pip helps you to:

Work out what will happen next by looking at clues in the text.

This means that she is there to help you to make predictions about what will happen after a given point.

Pip helps you to look at clues in the text to support your predictions of what will happen in the future.



When Have We Seen Predicting Pip?

Predicting Pip questions are rare. In the last three years, there have only been two Predicting Pip questions in the Year 6 SATs and one in the Year 2 SATs.
