- 3) The Morning Show or Country Time could be on, depending on whether it was morning or evening when Sofia had a shower.

2) Finlay is not correct. The children should notice that the minute hand and hour hand are lined up once every hour (with the exception of 11 o' clock times). These times are not exact. For example, by the time the clock is showing 5 past 1 the hour hand will have progressed on slightly past the 5. This difference will increase a little more each hour. The hands line up at approximately 1:05, 2:11, 3:16, 4:22, 5:27, 6:33, 7:38, 8:43, 9:49 and 10:55.'
