He painted in many styles



He was one of the creators of a style called Cubism


Creates different views of subjects together in the same picture Paintings appear fragmented and abstracted



Remember to mix up the view points!


















Pick a shape for the head.




Divide the head, stop before half way




Draw a nose starting from the line you drew to divide the face.




From the nose draw a line to the chin




Choose a mouth and draw one half on one side of the line.
Then draw the other half




Choose an eye to draw on one side of the face




Choose another eye to draw on the other side.
Perhaps choose a different view point?




Add a few extra details






Go over your face in pen!
