TO LOOK FOR:

- Pinecone

- Rocks with different features and colors

- Two types of trees (leaf trees and pine trees)
- Frozen puddles
- Birds
- Bird feathers

TO SMELL:

- Tree bark
- Snow
- Pine tree
- Fresh air (discuss what makes it smell fresh)

TO LISTEN FOR:

- Birds chirping
