Circus Segmenting Game



You will need:

- Large space, e.g. a hall
- Balls 1 between 2

How to play:

- 1. Children work in pairs and stand opposite a partner. Each pair has a ball.
- 2. Tell children that they are going to be like clowns in today's story, practising their ball skills!
- 3. Call out an 'ow' word, e.g. down.
- 4. Child A passes the ball to their partner while sounding out the first phoneme in the word, e.g. d.
- 5. Child B then passes the ball back to Child A while sounding out the next phoneme in the word, e.g. ow.
- 6. Continue until the whole word has been sounded out, e.g. d-ow-n.
- 7. Discuss how many phonemes are in the word.
- 8. Repeat with other 'ow' words.
