## Rainforest Leaf Story

## You will need:

- Rainforest Leaf Template
- Green paper or card (several sheets per child)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Hole punch or stapler (optional)
- Treasury tags (two per child, if using a hole punch)



- 1. Carefully, cut out the **Rainforest Leaf Template**. You may wish to print it on card to make it easier to draw around.
- 2. Draw around the template onto a piece of green paper or card.
- 3. Carefully, cut out your green leaf page.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 to 3. Each leaf will be a page in your book. You can choose how many pages you need.
- 5. Write your rainforest story on your leaves. Be as creative as you can! You might want to use line guides or draw your own lines to keep your writing neat.
- 6. Ask an adult to help you attach your leaf pages together to create your book. You could staple the pages together or use a hole punch.
- 7. If using a hole punch, punch two holes in the side of your leaf pages. Push treasury tags through the holes to secure the pages together.
- 8. Display your Rainforest Leaf Story for your friends to read and enjoy! You could even make more and create a library, just like Doris the loris!
